The **Mobile Thomas Aveling Museum** includes (1) details of a unique handwritten sailing log-book (from sailing yacht Sally) written by Thomas Aveling - covering the period 1880 to 1881, (2) an original watercolour from 1890 of Boley Hill House in Rochester (the last home of Thomas Aveling), (3) a working scale-model of an original Thomas Aveling (pre-Porter) traction engine (1858), (4) original photographs (from local residents) and memorabilia of the RRA 1982 Thomas Aveling Centenary Road Run (between Rochester and Hoo) and other items relating to the life of Thomas Aveling.
